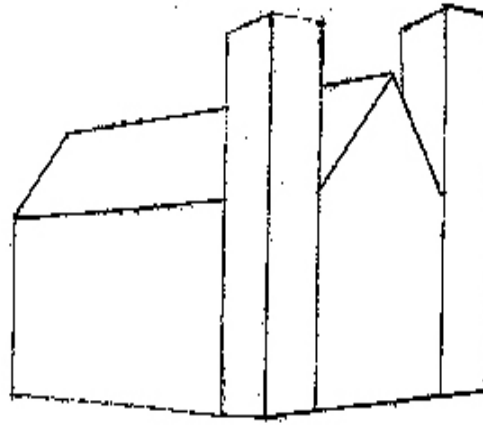


## FRONT DOUBLE TOWER

This imposing massing is readily identified through the height of the main façade. The towers are often of matching or similar size. Should one tower be dramatically higher than the massing, it may be more akin to a front corner tower. The front towers must rise well above the roof line and any other architectural feature. Examples: 1. St. Ann's Roman Catholic Church (Penetanguishene), 2. Martyrs Shrine (Midland), 3. St. Joseph's Roman Catholic Church (Chatham-Kent), 4. Vaishno Devi Hindu Temple (Oakville)
