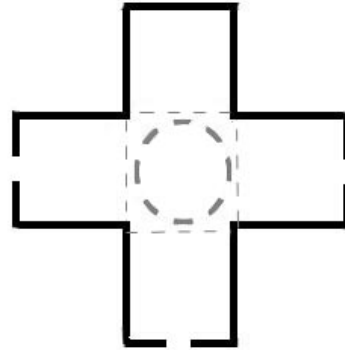


# GREEK CROSS

This typology is named for the compact form of traditional and historical Greek Orthodox churches – with a plan formed by four arms of equal length that cross in the centre, creating a symmetrical square cross. Examples: 1. St. Anne's Anglican Church (Toronto), 2. St. Andrew's United Church (Elizabethtown-Kitley), 3. Russian Orthodox Church of Christ the Saviour (London), 4. St. Nektarios Greek Orthodox Church (Chatham)
