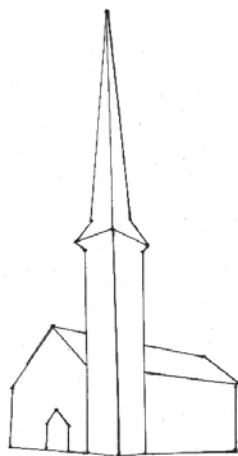


## FRONT CORNER TOWER

This typology represents an asymmetrical main façade with a single tower placed at the corner. It often appears on places of worship located at intersecting street corners. This type may include buildings with two towers on the main façade – but where the smaller tower is much lower, so that the overall impression is one of tension and asymmetry. The entry may be through the tower or beside it. Examples: 1. First Evangelical Lutheran Church (Toronto), 2. St. George's Anglican Church (Georgina), 3. St. Andrew's Presbyterian Church (Windsor), 4. Bath United Church (Loyalist)
